

“Seal Coat Phase” of the Paving Project

The Tanoan Community is having their roads paved. This is a big inconvenience to the residents however it has to be done every six years to maintain the roads. The schedule for each road is on this potential Phase II 'Coat Seal "colored map. This map is preliminary and subject to change. You can also get a copy of the map at the Tanoan Association Office. The schedule will be on Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays. May 24th, 25th, 26th and 31st. June 1st, 2nd, 7th, 8th, 9th, 13th, 14th and 15th. They will be doing each section from 7am – 7pm on these days. We are asking everyone for the help in this process. You will **not be able to drive or walk on the area they are working on that day until after 7:00PM. You will have to leave before 7:00AM in the morning when they are doing your street or a street that you use on your route.**

It is **ok** and **even better** if you **park up on the sidewalk** of the road that you can park on (not on your road). Please keep all animals off the new pavement. This stuff is really messy stuff that you do not want underneath your car, on the sidewalk, driveway or in your home. Make sure you know the day they will be doing your road. You do not want to back your vehicle on the pavement when they are working on it. It will ruin your car. **The residents will be liable for any damages to their vehicle, their guest's vehicles, any of their contractors or landscaping vehicles as well as any damage to the pavement, sidewalks or driveways and this can be very costly.** You will not have access to your road and other roads for **12 hours** each day. Please refer to the map so you do not have any problems. We will do everything possible to inform our residents of this process. **Torry Pines and Wimbledon** residents be aware of the side of the entrance you can drive on. We will block off the side we are working on so use the opposite side even if it feels confusing or weird. You do not want your vehicle damaged.

Make sure there are no vehicles on the street. **Please contact all your contractors, friends, UPS, FEDEX and school buses and let them know they will not be able to enter on the days your route to your home is being worked on.** Please do not drive through barricades; you do not want to damage your vehicle.
